SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 332, L.D. 451

FISCAL NOTE

This bill authorizes the State Controller to provide working capital advances to the Executive Department, Division of
Community Services, up to \$8,000,000 from the General Fund that must be repaid before June 30, 1991. This will result in a loss
of General Fund revenue from interest income. The amount of revenue loss can not be determined.

The Maine State Housing Authority will incur additional 12 costs in its study of ways to encourage the creation of affordable rental housing. These costs can be absorbed within 14 the authority's existing resources.'

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## STATEMENT OF FACT

20 This amendment deletes from committee amendment "B" the provisions regarding the educational bonus for affordable housing.
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The amendment removes the appropriation and allocation 24 sections of committee amendment "B" and provides for a working capital advance for fuel assistance for elderly and low-income 26 residents.
