An Act to Ensure Parental Notice of Harassment Orders Served on Minors.

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	17-A MRSA §506-A, sub-§3 is enacted to read:
5	3. A sheriff, deputy sheriff, constable, police officer or
	justice of the peace who forbids a minor to engage in conduct
7	described in subsection 1 shall notify the minor's parent or
9	guardian orally or in writing that the order has been issued.

	STATEMENT OF FACT
13	
	This bill requires that the parent or guardian of a minor
15	must be notified when the minor is forbidden to engage in conduct which is considered harassment.
