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An Act to Ensure Parental Notice of Harassment Orders Served on  
Minors.

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1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **17-A MRSA §506-A, sub-§3** is enacted to read:

5 3. A sheriff, deputy sheriff, constable, police officer or  
7 justice of the peace who forbids a minor to engage in conduct  
9 described in subsection 1 shall notify the minor's parent or  
11 guardian orally or in writing that the order has been issued.

13 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

15 This bill requires that the parent or guardian of a minor must be notified when the minor is forbidden to engage in conduct which is considered harassment.
