An Act to Allow Teachers to Obtain Retirement Benefits at 55 Years of Age if They Have 30 Years of Service.

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	5 MRSA §17852, sub-§11 is enacted to read:
5	11. Public school teachers. Public school teachers who
7	<u>retire on or after reaching 55 years of age with at least 30</u> years of service shall have their benefits computed in accordance with subsection 1.

13	Currently, members of the Maine State Retirement System may qualify for retirement benefits upon reaching 60 years of age or
