COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 342, L.D. 461, Bill, "An Act to Provide Complimentary Marine Resources Licenses to Certain Persons 75 Years of Age or Older"

Amend the bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following:

'An Act to Reduce the Lobster and Crab Fishing License Fee for Persons 70 Years of Age and Older'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'12 MRSA §6421, sub-§7, as amended by PL 1985, c. 379, §1, is further amended to read:

7. Fee. The fee for the license shall be \$53 for applicants from 17 years of age or older to 69 years of age and \$26 for those under 17 years of age or 70 years of age or older.

FISCAL NOTE

Enactment of this bill would result in a reduction of revenue to the General Fund of approximately \$7,644 for fiscal years 1989-90 and 1990-91 as well as a reduction in dedicated revenues to the lobster fund of \$1,820 for fiscal years 1989-90 and 1990-91.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment replaces the bill and provides a reduced fee for a lobster and crab fishing license for applicants 70 years of age or older and adds a fiscal note.
