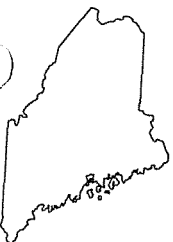

An Act to Establish Child Care Availability for Individuals in the
Substance Abuse Treatment System.



1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

3 Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the
5 General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

13 All Other \$100,000

15 These funds will be used to provide one
17 demonstration project for child care
19 services and programming in a woman's
halfway house anywhere in the State to be
determined by the Department of Human
Services.

21 All Other \$115,500

23 These funds will be used to provide 30
25 daycare vouchers for parents needing
27 them in order to participate in either
in-patient or extensive out-patient
29 programs for substance abusers.

31 STATEMENT OF FACT

33 This bill provides for daycare vouchers as needed and
appropriate. It also funds a demonstration project for
children's services in a woman's halfway house.
