## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act Relating to the Taxation of Aircraft.



1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	36 MRSA §1760, sub-§ 48, as amended by PL 1987, c. 865, §1, is further amended to read:
5	IS INTOMOT MICHAEL TO TENDE
	48. Scheduled airlines. The sale or lease of an aircraft,
7	or replacement or repair parts of an aircraft, used by a scheduled airline, based in this State, and which is regularly
9	used in the performance of service under the regulations of the Civil Aeronautics Board, Part 298 or under the United States
11	Code, Title 49, Section 1371. This subsection shall take effect retroactively beginning on January 1, 1984, and shall remain in
13	effect-until-October-1,-1989.

19	This bill removes the sunset provision on the sales tax exemption for aircraft and parts which are sold or leased by a
21	Maine-based scheduled airline.
