STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Amend the Election Laws.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

21-A MRSA §374, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 161, §6, is amended to read:

§374. Certain nominees at any time

If a person nominated for an office, other than United States Senator, or Representative to Congress ex-Governor, at a primary election or by a political committee dies, or withdraws or becomes disqualified on or after September 1st preceding the general election or less than 30 days prior to any other election before the general election, the Governor shall issue a proclamation under section 362. If a candidate withdraws or becomes disqualified on or after September 1st preceding the general election or less than 30 days prior to any other election, a political committee may not designate a replacement for the withdrawn or disqualified candidate.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to limit the circumstances under which candidates who have withdrawn or become disqualified after being nominated at a primary or by a political committee may be replaced. The bill provides that candidates, other than those for United States Senator and Representative, who withdraw or become disqualified on or after September 1st, preceding the general election, or on or after the 30th day preceding any other election, may not be replaced by another candidate.
