HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 358, L.D. 478, "Resolve, Requiring the Department of Educational and Cultural Services to Study Textbooks in Schools and School Libraries of the State"

Amend the amendment in the 5th line after the title (page 1, line 22 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Textbooks and"

Further amend the amendment in section 1 by striking out all of subsection 1

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 2 in the first line (page 1, line 42 in amendment) by striking out the following: "2." and inserting in its place the following: '1.'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in the 3rd line (page 2, line 13 in amendment) by striking out the following: "textbook" and inserting in its place the following: 'library book'

Further amend the amendment in the first line of the Appropriation (page 2, line 24 in amendment) by inserting at the beginning the following: 'Sec. 4.'

Further amend the amendment in the appropriation in the 4th line from the end (page 2, line 40 in amendment) by striking out the following: "and textbook"

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment retains most of the language of committee amendment "A" but deletes textbooks as a subject of the proposed study.
