31	STATEMENT OF FACT
33	This amendment reinstates the method of selecting the
35	Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Services in effect prior to 1983 changes. Under this amendment, the State Board of
37	Education will prepare a list of 3 candidates from which the Governor appoints one individual. The appointment is then
39	subject to review by the Joint Standing Committee on Education and confirmation by the Legislature. Under this amendment, the
41	commissioner will serve at the pleasure of the Governor.
