IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Change the Process of Selecting the Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Services.

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	20-A MRSA §251, as repealed and replaced by PL 1983, c. 123, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
5 7	<u>§251. Appointment; term</u>
9	The appointment and term of service of the commissioner shall be as follows.
11	1. Appointment. The commissioner shall be appointed by the State Board of Education.
13 15	A. The State Board of Education shall include the Governor or the Governor's designee in the selection process and
17	shall ensure that the Governor has an opportunity to meet and interview the candidate or candidates.
19	<u>B. The chair of the State Board of Education shall consult</u> with the Governor prior to final selection by the state
21	board. The state board shall consider the Governor's appraisal of the candidate or candidates under consideration
23	<u>prior to making an appointment.</u>
25 27	2. Term. The commissioner shall be appointed initially to serve a 3-year term.
29	A. The State Board of Education shall meet with the commissioner in executive session annually in December to review the performance of the commissioner at a time and
31	place determined by the chair of the State Board of Education.
33	B. The State Board of Education may extend the term of the
35	<u>commissioner by one year at a public meeting following the annual review of performance.</u>
37 39	3. Commencement of appointment process. At the time following the enactment of this section, this appointment process
41	shall commence as a vacancy occurs in the office of Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Services. The term of the
43	commissioner serving at the time this section is enacted shall be governed by the law in effect at the time of the commissioner's

51	The present method of selecting a Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Services does not encourage a bipartisan approach to the appointment process. The intent of this bill is
