An Act Concerning Removal and Replacement of Candidates on Election Ballots.

7	§374. Replacement of other nominees
9	1. Withdrawal of nominees; Governor's proclamation. Except as provided in subsection 2, if a person nominated for an office, other than United
11	States Senator, Representative to Congress or Governor, at a primary election or by a political committee dies,
13	withdraws or becomes disqualified before the general election, the Governor shall issue a proclamation under
15	section 362.
17	2. Limitations on replacement of withdrawn nominees. If the Governor issues the proclamation
19	provided for by section 362, a political committee may make a replacement nomination following a withdrawal
21	only if the person nominated for an office other than United States Senator, Representative to Congress or
23	Governor:
25	A. Withdraws on or before the 1st of August preceding the general election;
27	B. Withdraws because of a catastrophic illness,
29	diagnosed after the 65th day before the primary election day, that has permanently and
31	continuously incapacitated the candidate and would prevent performance of the duties of the office
33	sought and files with the Secretary of State a certificate accompanying the withdrawal request
35	which describes the illness and is signed by at least 2 licensed physicians; or
37	C. Dies prior to the general election.
39	3. Deadline for replacement by political
41	<u>committee.</u> Subject to the provisions of subsection 2, <u>a political committee may designate a replacement</u>
43	candidate no later than the 3rd Monday in August preceding the general election.

47	STATEMENT OF FACT
49	This bill is intended to limit the instances in which a party may replace a candidate who has withdrawn
51	from the general election. Barring the death or serious illness of the withdrawn nominee, no
53	replacement candidate may be substituted after the 1st

of August preceding the general election. If a replacement may be made, that candidate must be selected no later than the 3rd Monday in August before the general election.

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
