1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	17 MRSA 2264-A is enacted to read:

9	private property in violation of section 2264, the judge shal
	order that person to pay the owner of the property treble the
11	owner's cost of cleaning up or removing the litter.
