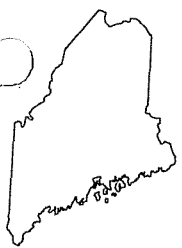

An Act Relating to Theft of Services.



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **17-A MRSA §357, sub-§3,** as amended by PL 1977, c. 183, §1,
5 is further amended to read:

7 3. As used in this section, "services" includes, but is not
9 necessarily limited to, labor, professional service, public
11 utility and transportation service, ski lift service, restaurant,
13 hotel, motel, tourist cabin, rooming house and like
15 accommodations, the supplying of equipment, tools, vehicles or
17 trailers for temporary use, telephone, telegraph, cable
19 television or computer service, gas, electricity, water or steam,
21 admission to entertainment, exhibitions, sporting events or other
events or services for which a charge is made.

17 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

19 This bill amends the definition of the crime of theft of
21 services to include theft of cable television services.
