SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 365, L.D. 496, Bill, "An Act to Make Allocations from the Maine Nuclear Emergency Planning Fund for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1990, and June 30, 1991"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 a new section to read:


'Sec. 2. 37-B MRSA §956, sub-§3 is enacted to read:

3. Grants and gifts. The Maine Emergency Management Agency is authorized to accept gifts, grants, research funds and to undertake contractual relationships with the Federal Government, other state and provincial governments, counties, municipalities, corporations, foundations and other legal entities to carry out the purposes for which it was created, including, without limitation, conducting emergency planning activities related to nuclear power facilities in adjacent states or provinces. Any amounts received for nuclear power facilities shall be credited to the Maine Nuclear Emergency Planning Fund.'

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment permits the Maine Emergency Management Agency to accept gifts for the purpose of funding emergency planning activities for plants located outside the State.
