An Act to Make Allocations from the Public Utilities Commission Regulatory Fund and the Public Utilities Reimbursement Fund for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1990, and June 30, 1991.

(EMERGENCY)



Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not 1 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted 3 as emergencies; and Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the 5 beginning of the next fiscal year; and 7 Whereas, certain obligations and expenses incident to the operation of the Public Utilities Commission will become due and payable on or immediately after July 1, 1989; and 11 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 13 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 15 safety; now, therefore, 17 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 19 Sec. 1. Allocation of the Public Utilities Commission Regulatory 21 Fund.
