An Act Concerning the Maintenance of Cattle Fences on State Land.



1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

3 23 MRSA §7157 is enacted to read:

5 §7157. Fencing

7 On any railroad line acquired pursuant to this chapter the
9 State shall have the same obligation as a railroad corporation to
11 build and maintain fences in accordance with sections 6021 and
6022. The Commissioner of Transportation shall have the
responsibility for administering this section.
