33	employees and agents as may be necessary in its judgment; and

37	reasonably implied from this Act+;

3	Sec. 3. 4 MRSA §1619 is enacted to read:
5 7	§1619. Gifts and contributions
1	The authority may accept gifts and contributions as provided
9	in section 1604, subsection 25, for the purpose of designing, constructing, reconstructing, renovating or acquiring court
11	facilities, including facilities for the Supreme Judicial Court, in accordance with section 1606, subsection 2. The authority may
13	accept gifts for the purpose of furnishing court facilities, including the facilities of the Supreme Judicial Court.
15	Furnishings include, but are not limited to, paintings, artifacts, furniture and similar articles.
17	
19	1. Acceptance of money. The authority, in accepting gifts of money, federal funds or other types of income, shall place this money in a special account for the purpose for which it is
21	provided. The authority may invest the money as provided in this chapter, subject to any limitations imposed by the donor.

25	2. Acceptance of furnishings. The authority, in accepting furnishings for court facilities, shall allocate the furnishings as directed by the donor.

33	This amendment authorizes the Maine Court Facilities Authority to accept federal funds, gifts and contributions for the construction, reconstruction, renovation, acquisition and
