**An Act to Provide a Sales Tax Exemption to Youth Scouting

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

7 which offers a program of outdoor and educational activities
9 aimed at developing good citizenship and healthy and useful
 living for boys or girls.
