An Act to Change the Number of Rooms Required for Hotel Liquor
Licenses.



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **28-A MRSA §1061, sub-§4, ¶A, as repealed and replaced by PL**
5 **1987, c. 623, §14, is amended to read:**

7 **A. The number of rooms required is based on the population**
9 **of the municipality in which the hotel is located.**

11 (1) If the hotel is located in a municipality of 3,000
13 or less population, the hotel must have at least ~~14~~ 12
15 adequate sleeping rooms.

17 (2) If the hotel is located in a municipality of more
19 than 3,000 but not more than 7,500 population, the
21 hotel must have at least 20 adequate sleeping rooms.

23 (3) If the hotel is located in a municipality of 7,500
25 or more population, the hotel must have at least 30
27 adequate sleeping rooms.

23 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

25 The purpose of this bill is to allow smaller motels to serve
27 liquor in rooms.
