COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 389, L.D. 520, Bill, "An Act to Expand the Jurisdiction of the District Courts to Include Violations within Municipal Harbors and to Impose the Same Penalties for Harbor Violations that Have Been Created for Land Use Violations"

Amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph T in the first 2 lines (page 1, lines 15 and 16 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "site location of development laws, Title 38, sections 481 to 485 and 488 to 490; the"

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 2 the following:

'Sec. 3. 30-A MRSA §4452, sub-§5, ¶¶P and Q, as enacted by PL 1989, c. 104, Pt. A, §45 and Pt. C, §10, are amended to read:

P. Waste water discharge licenses issued pursuant to Title 38, section 413, subsection 8; and

Q. Shoreland zoning ordinances adopted pursuant to Title 38, sections 435 to 447, including those which were state-imposed; and

Sec. 4. 30-A MRSA §4452, sub-§5, ¶R is enacted to read:

R. The laws pertaining to harbors in Title 38, chapter 1, subchapter I, local harbor ordinances adopted in accordance with Title 38, section 7 and regulations adopted by municipal officers pursuant to Title 38, section 2.'

Further amend the bill in section 3 in that part designated "§12." in the 4th line from the end (page 1, line 30 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined figure "4506" and inserting in its place the following: '4452'

Further amend the bill in section 3 in that part designated "§12." by striking out all of the last sentence (page 1, lines 31 to 33 in L.D.).

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read  
consecutively.
