COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 391, L.D. 522, Bill, "An Act to Amend Disorderly Conduct Offenses"

Amend the bill in paragraph C in the last 2 lines (page 1, lines 7 and 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "knowing that that person is not" and inserting in its place the following: 'without being'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment removes the knowledge requirement proposed by the bill for engaging in fighting. The person would be committing a Class E crime for engaging in fighting when not licensed or privileged to do so, thereby intentionally or recklessly annoying others.
