HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 394,
L.D. 525, Bill, "An Act to Facilitate Conversion of the Maine
State Retirement System Records to an Automated System"

Amend the amendment after that part designated "§18353."
(page 2, line 31 in amendment) by inserting the following:

'Sec. 8. 5 MRSA §18354, sub-§1, ¶¶B and C, as enacted by PL
1985, c. 801, §§5 and 7, are amended to read:

B. The member, before any retirement benefit becomes
effective ~~for him~~, must make contributions into the Members'
Contribution Fund for the years of out-of-state service on
the same basis as he the member would have made
contributions had the service been in the State, including
interest at a rate, to be set by the board, not to exceed
regular interest by 5 or more percentage points. Interest
shall be computed from the end of the year when those
contributions would have been made, if the service had been
in the State, to the date of payment; and

C. The member's last 10 years of creditable service before
the date of retirement must be in the State and no more than
10 years of service credit may be allowed for out-of-state
service; and'

Further amend the amendment by renumbering the sections to
read consecutively.
