17	Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:
19	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
21	become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
23	Whereas, there are now 3 separate standards for energy
25	efficiency in residential housing; and
27	Whereas, the Office of Energy Resources is required to publish a manual of accepted energy efficiency standards; and
29	Whereas, the immediate clarification of energy efficiency
31	standards will allow contractors to understand and comply with energy efficiency standards during the upcoming building season;

35	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
37	Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
39	safety; now, therefore,'
41	Further amend the bill in section 6, in subsection 3, in the 2nd line (page 1, line 42 in L.D.) by striking out the following:
