IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act Regarding Motor Vehicle Registration.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

29 MRSA §155 is enacted to read:

§155. Reregistration

Whoever discontinues the use of a registered motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer for an extended period and surrenders the plates to the Division of Motor Vehicles may reregister in accordance with this section. No portion of the fee may be repaid, but, for a reregistration of the same vehicle by the same person within one calendar year from the date of the original registration, a credit shall be applied to the cost of the reregistration. The credit shall be equal to 1/12 the cost of registration times the number of unused months remaining on the discontinued registration.

When a motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer is reregistered in accordance with this section, the reregistration shall be for a calendar year beginning in the month of that reregistration. The fee shall be the normal annual registration fee less any credit available under this section.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill addresses reregistration of a motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer for which the plates have been surrendered for an extended period by commencing the reregistration period when the reregistration takes place, rather than backdating it to the time when the plates were surrendered. Reregistration would be for a calendar year, but a portion of the previous registration fee, prorated for the unused months, would be credited against the fee for the reregistration.
