STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Require That Any State Service of Retired Local District Employees Be Included as Part of the Local District Service for the Purpose of Computing Retirement Benefits.

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

5 MRSA §18253, sub-§1, ¶D is enacted to read:

5 D. Notwithstanding this subsection, any member of the retirement system whose service is terminated as a state 7 employee and who becomes employed as a participating local district employee shall, if that member has not previously withdrawn that member's accumulated contributions, have 9 creditable service and earnable compensation as a state 11 employee included by that member's new employer with the service and compensation earned with that new employer. The 13 new employer shall make, from time to time, whatever contributions are necessary to provide the benefits under 15 the retirement system as had accrued by reason of the member's previous employment and as may accrue by reason of 17 the member's new employment.

STATEMENT OF FACT

23 Currently, state employees, which includes teachers, and district employees may local transfer their service for 25 retirement purposes from one type of employment to another, state to local. However, unless the new employer elects differently, 27 the rate of compensation paid for the earlier employment period will be based on the highest salary during that employment, not 29 during the entire period of the person's employment.

31 This bill requires that persons who transfer from state employment to local district employment shall have their state 33 service retirement credit computed at the highest salary paid during their total employment with any group participating in the 35 Maine State Retirement System. As used relative to the Maine State Retirement System, local district means a county or 37 municipality.
