An Act to Provide Complimentary Muzzle-loading Hunting Licenses to Resident Disabled War Veterans.



1	be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	12 MRSA §7076, sub-§4, as amended by PL 1983, c. 797, §4, is further amended to read:
5	Turcher amended to read:
	4. Resident disabled war veterans. A complimentary license
7	to hunt or fish, or a combination hunting and fishing license, and, if requested, a pheasant hunting permit, and a
9	muzzle-loading hunting license under section 7107-A shall be issued to any resident of Maine who:

13	A. Is a veteran, as defined in Title 37-A, section 28;
	B. Has a service-connected service-connected disability
15	evaluated at 70% or more as a result of honorable military service;

19	C. Has served in a combat zone during either World War I, World War II, the Korean War or the Viet-Nam Vietnam War; and
21	D. Applies for that license to the commissioner.
23	This application shall be accompanied by a photo copy of the applicant's final DD form 214 or other evidence satisfactory to
25	the commissioner that the applicant meets the requirements of this subsection. Each license issued under this subsection shall
27	remain valid through December 31st of the 2nd complete calendar year following the year of issuance.
