COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 236, L.D. 566, Bill, "An Act Relating to Tax Exemptions"

Amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill will result in a loss of \$500,000 in booked, but uncollected revenue in fiscal year 1989, thereby reducing surplus in the current year. There will also be a potential future loss of \$3,800,000 in unanticipated revenue. This amount has not been used in formulating present or future revenue estimates for budgeting purposes.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
