An Act to Regulate the Installation of Fire Sprinklers.



1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

	FIRE SPRINKLER CONTRACTORS
13	§1371. Definitions
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	As used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise
17	indicates, the following terms have the following meanings.
19	1. Certificate of registration. "Certificate of
19	registration" means the document issued to a person indicating
21	that the person is a qualified fire sprinkler installation
	supervisor. To be eligible for registration, the person must
23	have received a letter from the National Institute for the
	Certification in Engineering Technologies that the person has
25	successfully completed the examination at Level III for fire
2.77	protection automatic sprinkler systems layout provided for by
27	law. A State of Maine licensed engineer in the field of fire protection shall be eligible as a fire sprinkler installation
29	supervisor without passing the examination for Level III
29	certification.
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	2. Commissioner. "Commissioner" means the Commissioner of
33	Public Safety.
35	3. Department. "Department" means the Department of Public
27	Safety.
37	4. Fire sprinkler installation supervisor. "Fire sprinkler
39	installation supervisor" means an individual registered by the
	State as qualified to judge whether the installation, maintenance
41	and services of fire sprinklers meet the standards provided by
	law and state rules.
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	Fire sprinkler system. "Fire sprinkler system" means an
45	assembly of overhead piping or conduits that conveys water with
47	or without other agents to dispersal openings or devices to
47	extinguish, control or contain fire and to provide protection from exposure to fire or the products of combustion, designed in
49	accordance with a national or state standard recognized by the
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State Fire Marshal.

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6. Fire sprinkler system contractor. "Fire sprinkler system contractor" means a person or organization licensed to undertake, represents itself as being able to undertake or does undertake the plan, sale, installation, maintenance or servicing of a fire sprinkler system or any part of such a system.

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7. Installation. "Installation" means the initial placement of equipment or the extension, modification or alteration of equipment after the initial placement.

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8. License. "License" means the document issued to a contractor authorizing the contractor to engage in the fire sprinkler system business in this State.

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9. Maintenance. "Maintenance" means to maintain in the condition of repair that provides performance as originally planned.

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10. Service. "Service" means to maintain, repair or test.

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§1372. Applicability

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1. License required. Any person who undertakes to plan, sell, install, maintain or service a fire sprinkler system, or any part thereof, within this State must be licensed by the State Fire Marshal. Fees for licensure and renewal sufficient to cover their costs shall be collected. A person shall not be identified as a fire system sprinkler contractor or any similar term unless licensed by the State.

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2. Fire sprinkler installation supervisor. Each fire sprinkler system contractor shall employ at least one fire sprinkler installation supervisor. Twelve months after the termination of a fire sprinkler installation supervisor's employment with a fire sprinkler system contractor or 12 months after the expiration of a fire sprinkler installation supervisor's registration, the authority of the fire sprinkler system contractor to plan, sell, install, maintain or service fire sprinkler systems in this State shall cease, unless the fire sprinkler system contractor obtains a new fire sprinkler installation supervisor. A fire sprinkler system contractor who has lost the contractor's fire sprinkler installation supervisor within 12 months of the supervisor's license expiration shall qualify for a new license with the condition that the contractor replace the fire sprinkler installation supervisor to meet the provisions of this section. No 2 or more fire sprinkler system contractors shall contemporaneously employ the same fire sprinkler installation supervisor. During any period after a fire sprinkler contractor has lost the contractor's fire sprinkler installation supervisor and before securing a qualified

- replacement, all plans submitted for review to the State Fire
 Marshal shall be reviewed, approved and signed by a person who

- 7 <u>A person who has had at least 10 years prior supervisory</u> experience in the design or installation of fire sprinkler
- 9 <u>systems in the United States may qualify as a fire sprinkler</u> <u>installation supervisor if that person applies for registration</u>
- before July 1, 1990, provides a sworn statement of reference from 3 individuals as to the person's experience and is approved by
- the Advisory Council created in section 1379. Any person so registered as a fire sprinkler installation supervisor must, in
- order to be reregistered, provide proof of successful completion of the examination of Level III of the National Institute for the
- 17 <u>Certification in Engineering Technologies, NICET, by July 1, 1995.</u>
- 19 <u>Each fire sprinkler installation supervisor must be registered by the State Fire Marshall, pursuant to rules and regulations</u>
- 21 <u>promulgated by the commissioner.</u> Registration fees sufficient to cover related costs should be charged. Within 10 days after
- 23 <u>terminating employment with a licensed fire sprinkler system</u> <u>contractor</u>, a fire sprinkler installation supervisor shall notify
- in writing the State Fire Marshal of that fact.
- 27 3. Posting of license. Each license issued under this chapter shall be posted in a conspicuous place in the fire sprinkler system contractor's place of business. A license is not transferable.

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4. Municipal licenses. No municipality may require fire sprinkler system contractors to be municipally licensed nor shall any municipality issue a permit for any fire sprinkler system unless satisfied that the person applying for the permit complies with this chapter.

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§1373. Plan review

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Prior to construction or addition of any life-safety fire sprinkler system, as defined by the State Fire Marshal or prior to an addition involving more than 20 new sprinkler heads to a fire sprinkler system regulated by the National Fire Protection Association, Rules and Guidelines, Chapter 13, a fire sprinkler system contractor shall obtain a permit from the State Fire Marshal review the plan for construction or alteration and charge a reasonable fee for the review and permitting process. All plans or drawings for construction or alteration of fire sprinkler systems shall prominently display the fire sprinkler system contractor's license number, as well as the fire

- sprinkler installation supervisor's registration number. Each permit issued shall be displayed prominently at the site of construction or alteration.

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- The State Fire Marshall shall not issue a license under this chapter unless the applicant files with the application proof of comprehensive liability insurance with coverage in an amount of \$500,000 for single limit and proof of workers' compensation insurance for fire sprinkler system planning, sale, installation, maintenance or servicing. Proof of insurance shall consist of a certificate executed by the insurer authorized to do business in this State, indicating that the insurance cannot be terminated without 30 days' prior written notice to the State Fire Marshal.

§1375. Employees

- The commissioner may appoint, subject to the Civil Service
 Law, such employees as may be necessary to carry out this
 chapter. Any person so employed shall be under the
 administrative and supervisory direction of the State Fire
 Marshal.

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- 27 <u>All fees received by the department shall be paid to the State Treasurer and shall be used for carrying out this chapter.</u>
 29 <u>Any balance of these fees shall not lapse but shall be carried forward as a continuing account to be expended for the same purposes in the following fiscal years.</u>
 - §1377. Investigation of complaints; revocation of license
- The commissioner shall investigate or cause to be investigated all complaints made to the commissioner and all cases of noncompliance with or violation of this chapter. The commissioner may suspend or revoke a license pursuant to Title 5, section 10004. The commissioner may refuse to issue or renew a license or the Administrative Court may suspend, revoke or refuse to renew the license of a fire sprinkler system contractor who is found guilty of:
 - 1. Fraud or deceit. The practice of any fraud or deceit in obtaining a license;
- 2. Negligence or misconduct. Any gross negligence, incompetency or misconduct in the performance of the work of making fire sprinkler installations. Continued failure to conform to standards or rules adopted by the department shall be prima facie evidence of gross negligence or incompetency;

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	3. Violation of law. Any violation of this chapter or any
3	rule adopted by the department; or
5	4. Conviction of crime. Subject to the limitations of
7	Title 5, chapter 341, conviction of a crime which involves dishonesty or false statement or which relates directly to the
9	practice of fire sprinkler installation, or conviction of any crime for which incarceration for one year or more may be imposed.
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11	The commissioner, for reasons the commissioner may deem sufficient, may reissue a license to any person whose license has
13	been revoked.
15	§1378. Penalties; injunction
17	1. Penalties. Any person who undertakes to plan, sell, install, maintain or service a fire sprinkler system, or any part
19	thereof, without obtaining a license or employing a registered fire sprinkler installation supervisor as required by this
21	chapter, or after the license or registration has expired or has
23	been suspended or revoked or temporarily suspended or revoked, or who installs or alters a system without ultimately obtaining a
25	permit as required by this chapter is guilty of a Class E crime.
	2. Injunction. The State may bring an action in Superior
27	Court to enjoin any person from violating this chapter, regardless of whether proceedings have or may be instituted in
29	Administrative Court or whether criminal proceedings have been or may be instituted.
31 33	§1379. Fire Sprinkler Advisory Council
J J	1. Membership. The Fire Sprinkler Advisory Council
35	established in Title 5, section 12004-I shall consist of 7
37	persons appointed by the commissioner as follows:
	A. Three persons who have been actively engaged in the
39	management of a fire sprinkler system business for not less than 5 years preceding their appointments;
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43	B. One person from a municipal fire department of this State, nominated by the Maine Fire Chiefs Association;
45	C. One person from the Maine Federation of Fire Fighters;
47	D. One person who is either a fire protection engineer or a
49	mechanical engineer licensed in this State who is involved
± 3	in building construction design; and
51	E. One person from the property insurance industry,
	nominated by the Maine Mutual Insurance Association.

Terms of office. Members shall serve staggered 4-year
terms. Initial members shall have terms as follows: 3 members
for 2-year terms, 3 members for 3-year terms and one member for a
4-year term. The commissioner shall designate the term for each
initial member. A member may serve no more than 2 consecutive
4-year terms.
3. Quorum. Four members shall constitute a quorum for the
conduct of business.
4. Chair. The State Fire Marshal shall serve as chair of
the Fire Sprinkler Advisory Council, in an ex officio, nonvoting
role.
5. Compensation. Members shall be compensated according to
the provisions of Title 5, chapter 379.
6. Duties. In addition to other duties specified by the
commissioner, the Fire Sprinkler Advisory Council may:
A. Advise the State Fire Marshal concerning practices in
the fire sprinkler system industry and the rules necessary
to implement and administer this chapter;
co implement and administer this chapter,
B. Make recommendations to the State Fire Marshal regarding
forms and procedures for certificates of registration and
licenses, and plan reviews and fees charged for that review;
and
C. Advise the State Fire Marshal as to future changes that
this chapter may require to protect the public health,
safety and welfare.

§1380. Department rules
Following the procedures of Title 5, chapter 375, the
commissioner shall adopt such rules as are necessary for the
implementation of this chapter.
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Sec. 3. Effective date. This law shall take effect January 1,
1990, except that, notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes,
Title 32, section 1371, fire sprinkler installation supervisors
need not be registered until July 1, 1990.
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STATEMENT OF FACT
This bill requires that persons installing fire sprinkler
systems be licensed by the Department of Public Safety under
criteria and fees to be set by that department. Each contractor
must employ a person who is registered with the State as a fire
sprinkler installation supervisor, which registration requires a

- minimum educational standard. Additionally, each individual installation is to require a permit based on a review of the plans for the proposed installation. The Fire Sprinkler Advisory 1
- Council is created to advise the State Fire Marshal on issues
- 5 dealing with fire sprinkler safety.
