An Act to Amend the Liquor Laws.



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **28-A MRSA §1201, sub-§1**, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 45, Pt.
A, §4, is amended to read:

5
7 1. Licenses for sale of malt liquor and table wine. The
commission may issue licenses under this section for the sale and
distribution of malt liquor or wine to off-premise retail
licensees, as defined in section 2, subsection 27, paragraph A.
9 For the purposes of this section wine includes, but is not
11 limited to, those spirits described in section 2, subsection 36,
13 and wines of higher alcohol content such as madeira, port,
sherry, marsala and sake.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill allows the retail sale of wines with higher alcohol content, such as madeira, port, sherry, marsala and sake.
