19	words, "money due" the underlined words 'under the contract'

25	This amendment clarifies the bill but retains its intent to expedite resolution of claims by requiring a subcontractor to
27	submit a claim to the Department of Transportation within 90 days and then to arbitration within 60 days. At present, the
	subcontractor submits the claim 90 days after delivery, and then
29	the department submits it to arbitration, with no time limit, except the 7-year statute of limitations. In both cases, the
31	arbitration is binding. The amendment also retains the provision
33	which allows the department to withhold more than 5% of the money due, but not more than the amount claimed, pending resolution of
	the claim.
