COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 419, L.D. 584, Bill, "An Act to Make Allocations for the Administrative Expenses of the Bureau of Lottery, Department of Finance, for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1990, and June 30, 1991"

Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of the 9th to 13th lines (page 1, lines 32 to 37 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the following:

Further amend the bill by adding after section 5 the following:

Sec. 6. Report. The Commissioner of Finance shall report to the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs concerning the success of using direct mailing strategies initiated by the Bureau of Lottery by January 15, 1990.'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment reduces the State Lottery Fund allocations by \$500,000 in each year of the upcoming biennium. Those changes, along with an approved financial order, will have the following effect on General Fund revenues:
