An Act to Make Allocations for the Administrative Expenses of the
Bureau of Lottery, Department of Finance, for the Fiscal Years Ending
June 30, 1990, and June 30, 1991.

(EMERGENCY)



1 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
2 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
3 as emergencies; and

5 Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the
6 beginning of the next fiscal year; and

7
8 Whereas, certain obligations and expenses incident to the
9 operation of the Bureau of Lottery will become due and payable on
10 or immediately after July 1, 1989; and

11
12 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
13 create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
14 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
15 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
16 safety; now, therefore,

17 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

19 **Sec. 1. Allocation of fund.** In order to provide for the
20 necessary expenses of operation and administration of the Bureau
21 of Lottery, the following amounts, or as much as may be
22 necessary, are allocated from the revenues derived from
23 operations of the State Lottery Fund.

38 **Sec. 2. Allotments required.** Upon receipt of allotments duly
39 approved by the Governor, based upon work programs submitted to
40 the State Budget Officer, the State Controller shall authorize
41 expenditures from these allocations on the basis of these
42 allotments and not otherwise.

44 **Sec. 3. Legislative intent.** It is the intent of the Legislature
45 that the allocation of funds by the Legislature, as provided by
46 this Act, shall apply to the administrative expenses only and
47 that these allocations shall be allotted and approved under the
48 Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5.

50 **Sec. 4. Adjustments to allocations.** Allocations may be increased
51 or adjusted by the State Budget Officer with the approval of the
52 Governor to specifically cover those adjustments

1 determined to be necessary under any salary plan approved by the
Legislature and those reclassifications or range changes which
3 have been approved by the Department of Administration and
submitted for legislative review prior to the effective date of
5 this Act.

7 **Sec. 5. Exclusion.** Excluding sections 1 to 4 of this Act, up
to \$90,000 each fiscal year may be expended for Capital
9 Expenditures.

11 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
