An Act to Make Allocations for the Administrative Expenses of the Bureau of Lottery, Department of Finance, for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1990, and June 30, 1991.

(EMERGENCY)



Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not 1 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted 3 as emergencies; and 5 Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and 7 Whereas, certain obligations and expenses incident to the 9 operation of the Bureau of Lottery will become due and payable on or immediately after July 1, 1989; and 11 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 13 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 15 safety; now, therefore, 17 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 19 Sec. 1. Allocation of fund. Allotments required. Upon receipt of allotments duly approved by the Governor, based upon work programs submitted to the State Budget Officer, the State Controller shall authorize 41 expenditures from these allocations on the basis of these allotments and not otherwise. 43 Sec. 3. Legislative intent. It is the intent of the Legislature that the allocation of funds by the Legislature, as provided by 47 this Act, shall apply to the administrative expenses only and that these allocations shall be allotted and approved under the 49 Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5. 51 Sec. 4. Adjustments to allocations. Allocations may be increased or adjusted by the State Budget Officer with the approval of the 53 Governor to specifically cover those adjustments

3	have been approved by the Department of Administration and submitted for legislative review prior to the effective date of

7	Sec. 5. Exclusion. Excluding sections 1 to 4 of this Act, up to \$90,000 each fiscal year may be expended for Capital

11	Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
