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**An Act to Require a Hearing to Cancel Policies Issued under an  
Assigned Risk Plan.**

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1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **Sec. 1. 24-A MRSA §2913, sub-§1,** as enacted by PL 1973, c.  
5 339, §1, is amended to read:

7 1. Insured under an automobile assigned risk plan, except  
9 for the assigned risk insurance plan in section 2924;

11 **Sec. 2. 24-A MRSA §2924** is enacted to read:

13 **§2924. Assigned risk insurance plan**

15 No notice of cancellation of an assigned risk insurance plan  
17 is effective unless mailed or delivered by the insurer to the  
19 named insured at least 2 weeks prior to the effective date of  
21 cancellation. A post-office department certificate of mailing to  
23 the named insured at the address shown on the policy is proof of  
25 receipt of the mailing.

#### 21 STATEMENT OF FACT

23 This bill ensures that an automobile insurance policy under  
25 an assigned risk plan may not be cancelled without a 2-week prior  
notice.
