STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act Concerning Antique Automobiles and Horseless Carriages.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

The Secretary of State is authorized to design and issue 7 registration plates for antique autos, horseless carriages and street rods. These plates shall bear the inscriptions "Antique 9 Auto," "Horseless Carriage" or "Street Rod" and "Maine." Present owners of antique motor vehicles shall be permitted to keep their existing registration plate numbers for the new registration 11 plates issued under this section. The Secretary of State shall 13 allow the owner of an antique motor vehicle to use registration plates which were issued in the same year as the antique motor 15 vehicle was manufactured, provided that the date-of-manufacture was-1942-or-earlier motor vehicle is over 25 years old and the motor vehicle is registered as an antique motor vehicle under 17 this section. Any antique motor vehicle, including any antique 19 auto or horseless carriage, bearing registration plates with the year of manufacture must also carry, within it, a valid antique 21 motor vehicle registration certificate and the antique motor vehicle registration plates matching thecertificate. The 23 registration plates from-1942-or-earlier must have matching plate numbers, must be affixed to both the front and rear of the 25 antique motor vehicle and must conspicuously bear the year of manufacture. The fee for registration of an antique auto or 27 horseless carriage shall be \$12. The fee for registration of a street rod shall be \$27.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides that any antique auto or horseless carriage bearing registration plates that were issued in the same year as that motor vehicle was manufactured must also carry, within the vehicle, a valid antique motor vehicle registration certificate and the antique motor vehicle registration plates matching the certificate.
