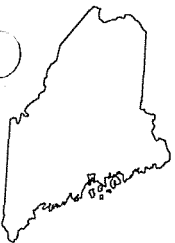

An Act to Expand the Excise Tax Exemption for Veterans.

1       **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3               **36 MRSA §1483, sub-§12 is amended to read:**

5               12.   **Certain veterans.**   Automobiles owned by veterans who  
7               are granted free registration of such vehicles by the Secretary  
9               of State under Title 29, section 251 and automobiles owned by  
              veterans who have a disability of 100% regardless of whether the  
              disability is service connected;

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

15               This bill exempts automobiles of veterans who have a 100%  
              disability from excise tax regardless of whether the disability  
17               is service connected.   Currently, only automobiles of veterans  
              with 100% service connected disabilities are exempt.
