HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 432, L.D. 597, Bill, "An Act
Relating to the Dig-safe Law"

Amend the bill by striking out all of paragraph A (page 1,
lines 6 to 14 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

A. Nothing in this section shall ~~apply~~ applies to the
Department of Transportation, a public utility, a municipal
public works or sewer department or a sanitary or sewer
district, if written or verbal notice of the approximate
location and time of that excavation is given by that
utility, department or district person to the owner or a
designated representative of ~~these other utilities,~~
~~districts, municipal sewer or public works departments~~ the
owner of any underground facilities in the area of the
proposed excavation prior to any excavation taking place.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment makes technical changes in the language to
simplify it and conform it to the terminology used elsewhere in
the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 23, section 3360-A.
