HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 438,
L.D. 603, Bill, "An Act to Extend the Exemption for Sales Tax for
Certain Instrumentalities of Interstate or Foreign Commerce"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in subsection 48 in the 1st
and 2nd lines (page 2, lines 9 and 10 in amendment) by striking
out the following: ", or replacement or repair parts of an
aircraft," and inserting in its place the following: '~~or~~
~~replacement-or-repair-parts-of-an-aircraft,~~'

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment would reduce the fiscal impact of the bill so
that the loss of revenue to the General Fund would be \$2,087,401
in fiscal year 1989-90 and \$3,460,709 in fiscal year 1990-91.
The corresponding loss of revenue to the municipal revenue
sharing program would be \$112,715 in fiscal year 1989-90 and
\$186,981 in fiscal year 1990-91.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment would remove aircraft replacement or repair
parts from the 3-year extension of the tax exemption for certain
scheduled airlines.
