HOUSE AMENDMENT " **B** to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 438,  
L.D. 603, Bill, "An Act to Extend the Exemption for Sales Tax for  
Certain Instrumentalities of Interstate or Foreign Commerce"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in the last line (page 2,  
line 16 in amendment) by striking out the following: "1992" and  
inserting in its place the following: '1990'

**FISCAL NOTE**

This amendment would reduce the fiscal impact of the bill so  
that the loss of revenue to the General Fund would be \$2,477,745  
in fiscal year 1989-90 and \$1,099,853 in fiscal year 1990-91.  
The corresponding loss of revenue to the municipal revenue  
sharing program would be \$133,155 in fiscal year 1989-90 and  
\$59,107 in fiscal year 1990-91.

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment reduces the extension of the tax exemption  
for certain scheduled airlines from 3 years to one year.
