HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 438,
L.D. 603, Bill, "An Act to Extend the Exemption for Sales Tax for
Certain Instrumentalities of Interstate or Foreign Commerce"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in the first line (page 1,
line 21 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Sec. 1."

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 2.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment would reduce the fiscal impact of the bill so
that the loss of revenue to the General Fund in fiscal year
1989-90 would be \$666,579 and \$1,099,853 in fiscal year 1990-91.
The corresponding loss of revenue to the municipal revenue
sharing program would be \$35,822 in fiscal year 1989-90 and
\$59,107 in fiscal year 1990-91.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment removes that provision which would have
extended the tax exemption for certain scheduled airlines for 3
more years.
