An Act to Increase the Price Farmers Receive for Milk.



1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	7 MRSA §2954, sub-§12 is enacted to read:
5	12. Class II milk. In establishing minimum prices and allowances for transportation under this section, the commission
7	may not establish differences in the amount paid to farmers for different categories of Class II milk.

11	STATEMENT OF FACT
13	This bill prevents the Maine Milk Commission from allowing a
15	dealer to deduct a transportation allowance for different categories of Class II milk.
