An Act Relating to Abandoned Dogs.



1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	7 MRSA §3913-A is enacted to read:
5	<u>§3913-A. Expedited procedures for abandoned dogs</u>
7	<u>A shelter may sell or give away an abandoned dog in accordance with the provisions of this section before the</u>
9	expiration of the 8-day waiting period in section 3913, provided that:

13	<ol> <li>License. A license is first obtained in accordance with section 3922; and</li> </ol>
15	2. Abandonment. The dog was:
17	A. Found in a public place and the shelter has reasonable grounds to believe the dog was intentionally left there;
19	B. Discovered in or near a domicile vacated by the dog's
21	owner; or
23	C. Owned by a person who has indicated, orally or in writing, that the person has abandoned the dog.
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29	STATEMENT OF FACT
29	This bill eliminates the 8-day waiting period that a shelter
31	must wait before a dog which has been obviously abandoned can be sold or given away.

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
