An Act to Make Allocations for Various Funds of the Department of Environmental Protection for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1990 and June 30, 1991.

(EMERGENCY)



1 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
3 as emergencies; and

5 Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the
beginning of the next fiscal year; and

7 Whereas, certain obligations and expenses incident to the
9 operation of the department will become due and payable on or
immediately after July 1, 1989; and

11 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
13 create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
15 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety; now, therefore,

17 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

19 **Sec. 1. Allocation of the Ground Water Oil Clean-up Fund.** Income
21 to the Ground Water Oil Clean-up Fund for the next 2 fiscal
years, from July 1, 1989 to June 30, 1990, and from July 1, 1990
23 to June 30, 1991, shall be segregated, apportioned and disbursed
as designated in the following schedule.
