An Act to Remove the Provision that Industrial Plant Employees Who Perform Electrical Work Need Not Be Licensed.



1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	32 MRSA §1102-A, as amended by PL 1981, c. 501, §59, is repealed.

7	STATEMENT OF FACT
9	Currently, employees of industrial and manufacturing
11	concerns need not be licensed to perform electrical work. This bill removes that exemption and thereby requires that employees
13	must be licensed to perform electrical work.
