NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

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An Act to Remove the Provision that Industrial Plant Employees Who Perform  
Electrical Work Need Not Be Licensed.

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1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 32 MRSA §1102-A, as amended by PL 1981, c. 501, §59, is  
5 repealed.

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#### STATEMENT OF FACT

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13 Currently, employees of industrial and manufacturing  
concerns need not be licensed to perform electrical work. This  
bill removes that exemption and thereby requires that employees  
must be licensed to perform electrical work.
