SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 481, L.D. 661, Bill, "An Act to Establish Occupational Health and Safety Standards for Operators of Video Display Terminals"

Amend the amendment in that part designated "§252." by striking out all of subsections 1, 2 and 3.

Further amend the amendment in that part designated "§252." by renumbering the subsections consecutively.


Amend the amendment by inserting before section 2 the following:

§256. Data collection

The bureau shall collect and maintain data documenting the frequency and nature of complaints filed under this law, and of complaints related to terminal work which are filed with the Workers' Compensation Commission. The bureau shall report such data to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over labor matters by January 1, 1991.

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment removes those portions of the committee amendment mandating work station standards, work breaks and leave for vision examinations and adds a requirement that the Bureau of Labor Standards document and report to the Legislature, complaints filed by video display terminal operators.
