An Act to Permit the Registration of Recreational Vehicles for Either a Six-month or One-year Period.



1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

3 29 MRSA §106, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

5 4. Registration for camp trailers. Registration for camp
7 trailers is from March 1st to the last day of August of the same
9 calendar year or from March 1st to the last day of February of
11 the next calendar year, at the owner's option. On and after
13 February 1st, it is lawful to use and display on these vehicles
15 the number plates, or suitable devices in lieu of those plates,
17 issued for the registration period. The registration fee for
19 camp trailers registered for 6 months shall be 1/2 of the fee as
21 provided in section 244.

STATEMENT OF FACT

17 This bill allows owners of camp trailers to register those
19 vehicles for 6 months or one year, at the owner's option. If an
21 owner chooses to register the vehicle for 6 months, the
registration fee will be 1/2 the annual fee.
