25	Further amend the bill in subsection 13, in paragraph B in the 3rd line (page 1, line 18 in L.D.) by striking out the
27	following: "or" and inserting in its place the following ','
29	Further amend the bill in subsection 13, in paragraph B in the 4th line (page 1, line 19 in L.D.) by inserting after the
31	following: " <u>menu</u> " the following: ' <u>,or in an open manner where the</u> food order or food product is obtained'
33	Further amend the bill in subsection 13, in paragraph B in
35	the last line (page 1, line 20 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "glutamate." and inserting in its place the following:
37	' <u>glutamate; or</u> '
39	Further amend the bill in subsection 13 by adding at the end the following:
41	'C. There is a conspicuously displayed directory to which
43	customers can refer for information on the contents of
45	unpackaged products offered for sale.'
