29	FISCAL NOTE
31	This bill could result in an increased number of filings throughout the State of Maine court system. However, the
33	Judicial Department would absorb these additional costs utilizing existing resources.'

37	STATEMENT OF FACT
J.	This amendment clarifies the bill by prohibiting the
39	motorcycle operator from intentionally or knowingly raising the front wheel off the surface on a public way or in a public
41	parking lot. Violation would be a traffic infraction as defined by the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 29, section 1, subsection
43	17-C. The amendment also drops the exemption in the bill for law enforcement officers.
